On a video call, the human brain works harder to interpret non-verbal cues like body language and tone of voice. It is also scientifically proven that it's harder to focus and give attention during a standard video conference vs. in-person meetings.

Despite the initial challenges and adjustment period, 76.5% of managers found that remote and flexible working generally increased productivity, and 62.8% agreed that it increased employee motivation.⁵ Many employees, especially younger generations, prefer and expect remote or hybrid working environments that foster a mix of in-office, remote, nomadic, and untethered (desk-hopping) working arrangements.⁶

As companies plan for the future, the idea of traditional office spaces may be redefined to flexible on-site workspaces that can be used for many different purposes and re-configured as required. Many companies have reduced their real estate footprint or created smaller satellite spaces that teams use on an as-needed or rotational basis. 
